

SunFoods, LLC Website Privacy Statement

The Effective Date of this Website Privacy Statement (the “Statement”) is August 11, 2020

Capitalized terms used but not defined herein shall have the same meanings given them in the Terms of Use Agreement posted on this Website.

1. ACKNOWLEDGEMENT AND ACCEPTANCE OF TERMS

SunFoods, LLC (the “Company” or “we”) is committed to protecting your privacy. We will never rent or sell your personally identifiable information to third parties for marketing purposes. We will never share your contact information with another User, without your consent. Any sensitive information that you provide will be secured with an industry standard protocol and technology system. In the limited situations provided in paragraph 4 of this Statement, we may disclose some user information to third parties. (Please see paragraph 4 for more details.)

This Statement sets forth our current privacy practices with regard to the information we collect when you or your computer interact with our Websites. By accessing one of our Websites, you acknowledge and fully understand this Statement and freely consent to the information collection and use practices described in this Statement.

2. PARTICIPATING MERCHANT POLICIES

Related services and offerings with links from this Website, including Third-Party Sites, have their own privacy statements that can be viewed by clicking on the corresponding links within each respective Third-Party Site. Online merchants and others who participate in our services are encouraged to participate in industry privacy initiatives and to take a responsible attitude towards consumer privacy. However, since we do not have direct control over the policies or practices of participating merchants and other third parties, we are not responsible for the privacy practices or contents of Third-Party Sites. We recommend and encourage that you always review the privacy policies of merchants and other third parties before you provide any personal information or complete any transaction with such parties.

3. INFORMATION WE COLLECT AND HOW WE USE IT

We collect certain information from and about Users in three main ways: (1) directly from our web server logs, (2) information obtained and stored with cookies and (3) information supplied by the User. Each way of obtaining information is described below.

a. Web Server Logs

When you visit our Website, we may track information to administer the site and analyze its usage. Examples of information we may track include:

- Your Internet protocol address.
- The kind of browser or computer you use.

- Number of links you click within the site.
- State or country from which you accessed the site.
- Date and time of your visit.
- Name of your Internet service provider.
- Web page you linked to our site from.
- Pages you viewed on the site.

b. Use of Cookies

We may use cookies to personalize or enhance the User's experience. A cookie is a small text file that is placed on your hard disk by a web page server. Cookies cannot be used to run programs or deliver viruses to your computer. Cookies are uniquely assigned to you, and can only be read by a web server in the domain that issued the cookie to you. One of the primary purposes of cookies is to provide a convenience feature to save you time. For example, if you personalize a web page, or navigate within a site, a cookie helps the site to recall your specific information on subsequent visits. Hence, this simplifies the process of delivering relevant content and eases site navigation by providing and saving your preferences and login information as well as providing personalized functionality.

We reserve the right to share aggregated site statistics with partner companies, but do not allow other companies to place cookies on our Website unless there is a temporary, overriding customer value (such as merging into our Websites a site that relies on third-party cookies).

You have the ability to accept or decline cookies. Most web browsers automatically accept cookies, but you can usually modify your browser setting to decline cookies. If you reject cookies by changing your browser settings then be aware that this may disable some of the functionality on our Website.

4. INFORMATION SUPPLIED BY USERS

Visitors to our Website can register to purchase services. When you register, we will request some personal information such as first and last name, address (home or other physical location), email address, telephone number, facsimile number, password to SunFoods, LLC website account, and other relevant information. If you are purchasing goods, we will request financial information including (1) name on credit card, (2) billing address for credit card, (3) credit card number and (4) credit card expiration date. Any financial information we collect is used only to bill you for the services you purchased. If you purchase by credit card, this information may be forwarded to your credit card provider through financial third parties that authorize credit card transactions. For other types of registrations, we will ask for the relevant information. You may also be asked to disclose personal information to us so that we can provide assistance and information to you. For example, such data may be warranted in order to provide online technical support and troubleshooting.

We will not disclose personally identifiable information we collect from you to third parties without your permission except as follows:

- To fulfill your orders for goods. In this connection, we may disclose your information to our employees and/or to employees, agents and affiliates of Authorize.Net, our Internet Protocol (“IP”) payment gateway service provider, and DHL, our shipper, in order to process your credit card payment and package, mail and deliver your order. We will only share with outside parties the information they need to deliver the specific service that they are contracted to provide;
- To protect and defend the rights or property of the Company or Users of the Websites, if we believe in good faith that disclosure of your information is necessary to do so;
- To respond to legal process or comply with law; or
- In connection with a merger, acquisition or liquidation of the Company.

5. USE OF WEB BEACONS OR GIF FILES

Our Websites may contain electronic images known as web beacons, sometimes also called single-pixel gifs, that allow us to count Users who have visited those pages and to deliver co-branded services. We may include web beacons in promotional email messages or newsletters in order to determine whether messages have been opened and acted upon. Some of these web beacons may be placed by third party service providers to help determine the effectiveness of our advertising campaigns or email communications. These web beacons may be used by these service providers to place a persistent cookie on your computer. This allows the service provider to recognize your computer each time you visit certain pages or emails and compile anonymous information in relation to those page views, which in turn enables us and our service providers to learn which advertisements and emails bring you to our Website and how you use the site.

6. ACCESSING WEB ACCOUNT INFORMATION

We cannot delete your personal information except by also deleting your user account. We may not accommodate a request to change information if we believe the change would violate any law or legal requirement or cause the information to be incorrect.

7. CALIFORNIA ONLINE PRIVACY PROTECTION ACT

The California Online Privacy Protection Act (“CalOPPA”) requires commercial websites and online services to post a privacy policy. The law’s reach stretches well beyond California to require any person or company in the United States (and conceivably the world) that operates

websites collecting personal identifiable information from California consumers to post a conspicuous privacy policy on its website stating exactly the information being collected and those individuals or companies with whom it is being shared.

10. CAN SPAM ACT

The CAN SPAM Act is a law that sets the rules for commercial email, establishes requirements for commercial messages, gives recipients the right to have emails stopped from being sent to them, and spells out tough penalties for violations.

We collect your email address in order to:

- Send information, respond to inquiries, and/or other requests or questions.
- Market to our mailing list or continue to send emails to our clients after the original transaction has occurred.

As provided above, your email address is only collected when you fill out a form or leave a comment on this website.

To be in accordance with the CAN SPAM ACT, we agree to:

- Not use false or misleading subjects or email addresses.
- Include the physical address of our business or site headquarters.
- Monitor third-party email marketing services for compliance, if one is used.
- Honor opt-out/unsubscribe requests quickly.
- Allow users to unsubscribe by using the link at the bottom of each email.

12. SECURITY

This Website uses 128-bit Secure Sockets Layer (SSL) technology for secure IP transactions to protect transaction data. To the extent that transactions are made through this Website, the payment gateway used for payments on the Website (Authorize.Net) employs encryption hardware and software methods and security protocols to protect User information. Authorize.Net is certified as compliant with the Payment Card Industry Data Security Standard. Administration of this Website is managed through a password secured site for authorized personnel appointed by the Company for security management.
