


Goes live mid-August to provide a user-friendly portal for all the information required to grow rice for SunRice

Will enhance the service already provided by Grower Services team


Examples of transactions with SunRice:

- View and advise changes to farm details eg share-farming arrangements




Examples of transactions with SunRice:

- Changes will be auto-filled to form to be signed and sent to SunRice




Examples of transactions with SunRice:

View, print or export receival details




Examples of transactions with SunRice:
